## Impact 2015 - 2016:

The profile of PE has been sustained in the school and the children have had access to a wider range of sporting activities, which has encouraged children to take part in more extra-curricular

activities. We are working towards achieving the silver kite mark next year. We have maintained a range of different **free** extra-curricular clubs. This number includes children who are not usually involved in as many sports over the year and have been identified as more sedentary from our baseline fitness test before Run to Rio. These were the year 5 girls so we offered a dance workshop to encourage the girls to participate in physical activity. The number of free extra-curricular sports club has also increased with more teachers running sports club. Last year (2014/2015) there were two teachers running sports clubs, in the spring - summer term, this equated to 4 clubs being run; tennis, gymnastics, rounders and lacrosse. This is in addition to the external clubs being run alongside.

The teachers who received training feel more confident in the subject. We now have a new scheme of work to follow, which has been rolled out from year 1 to year 6. We are now linked with BDB and through them we have links with Goldsworth Park, St. Johns, Pirbright, Maybury and Horsell. This means that if we want to get involved in any extra competitions, then we can organise with each other. This is particular good for organising friendlies to introduce the children to competition. We are now linked with our STARS schools, who are generally members of the WASPS association which means that we tend to compete against them in district competitions and can look to organise friendlies. Our STARS association has had PE networking where ideas have been shared regarding sports and PE in schools. This has also led to a new assessment framework to meet the needs of the new curriculum.

## 2016 - 2017 Vision:

To increase quality of PE lessons delivered in curriculum time.

To gain Silver School Games Mark (Kitemark) – work towards the objectives, with a view towards moving to Gold once this is achieved.

To continue to raise the awareness of the importance of a healthy lifestyle to targeted groups – begin to target Pupil Premium children, KS1 children and more sedentary children. Change for life club/Dance Woking for girls.

To participate in WASPS for Netball, football and cricket leagues.

To provide more opportunities for staff CPD.
