Key vocabulary

3D Form	is art in 3D. It can be made by carving, modelling or placing materials together. They can be made out of stone, wood, clay or any other material the artist wants to use.
Manipulate	handle or control (a tool, mechanism, information, etc.) in a skilful manner.
Clay	is a raw material made up of tiny particles of rock
coil	Coiling involves the rolling out of clay into a long thin sausage-like form
roll	<i>To cause something to turn over on to itself</i>
pinch	by forcing the thumb into the centre, gradually pinching out the walls to an even thickness and the desired shape
