To practise mixing primary colours to get secondary colours.

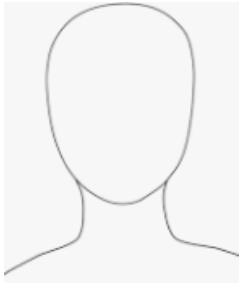
To use painting to share my ideas and thoughts.

Previous knowledge

Key Knowledge:

Portrait = a picture of a person usually showing their face.

Self-portrait = a picture of oneself done by oneself.

Key vocabulary

portrait	a picture of a person usually showing their face
secondary	A colour formed by mixing two primary colours
primary	Basic colours that can be mixed together to produce a secondary colour
mix	To combine colours to create a new colour
sketch	A rough outline—experimenting
mood	Feelings expressed in a painting
