To join materials together you can use glue, staple, sew, and tape.

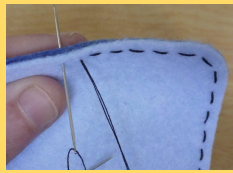
Cut

When planning and making a product we have to think about who it is for and why they need it.

You need to select the right material to make a puppet. Felt is a good material for joining a puppet together using glue, stapler or sewing.

Vocabulary	Definition
Cut	To use something sharp and remove a part.
Join	To fix two different parts together.
Material	A name of what something is made out of e.g
Stapler	A tool used to join two bits of paper, card or felt together with a staple.
Sew	To join two pieces of materials using a needle and thread.
Tools	Something you hold in your hand to and use to make something, for example needle, thread, stapler, glue stick.
Design	To make a detailed drawing or plan to show how something will be made.
Make	To create something you have designed.
Evaluative	To think about your puppet and what worked well and how you could make it better.
