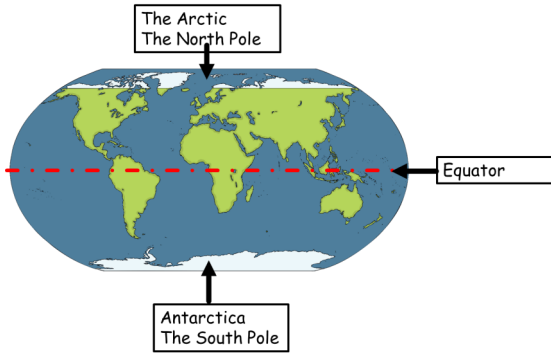




All Around the World



What have we already learnt?

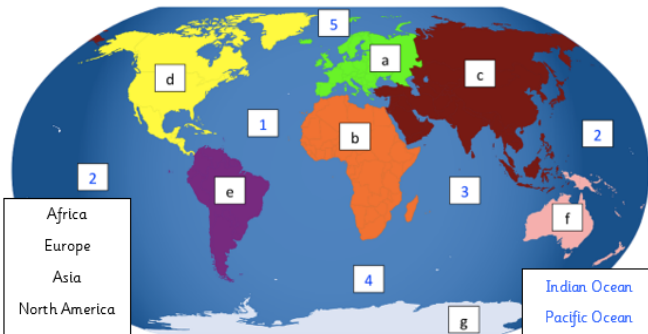
Previously, children have already learnt the countries within the UK. During EYFS and Year 1 the children have been using Atlas'. Children start to learn about the seven continents and five oceans so that they understand the wider world as well as the UK. They use atlases and maps more independently so that they can visualise what the continents look like.

You can use a venn diagram to compare. Compare the location, houses, food, climate and tourism in Jamaica and Scotland.

The equator is the middle of the earth. Places near the poles are cold and places near

Scotland– a country in Europe.
The capital city is Edinburgh.
Scotland is located in Europe.
