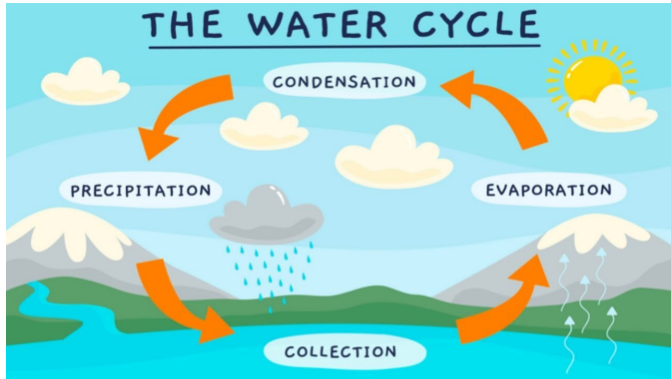




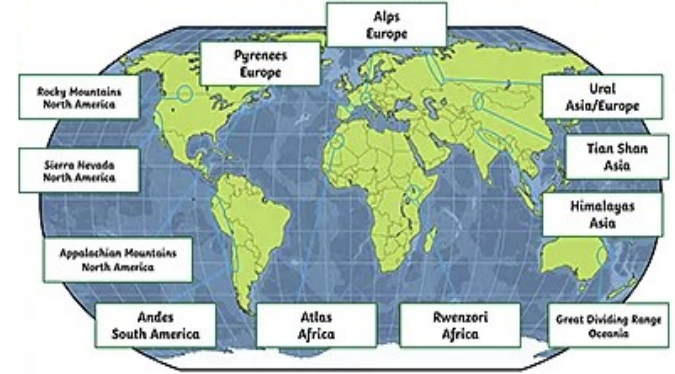

Mountain Ranges of the World



Vocabulary	Definition
Land use	How the land is used.
Mountain	A landform that rises higher than everything surrounding it, taller than a hill.
Evaporation	Process of turning liquid to vapour.
Precipitation	Rain, snow, sleet, hail
Condensation	Process where water becomes liquid.

Some mountains are found in groups called a mountain range but some can be on their own.

Mount Everest is the highest mountain above sea level.



What have we already learnt?
