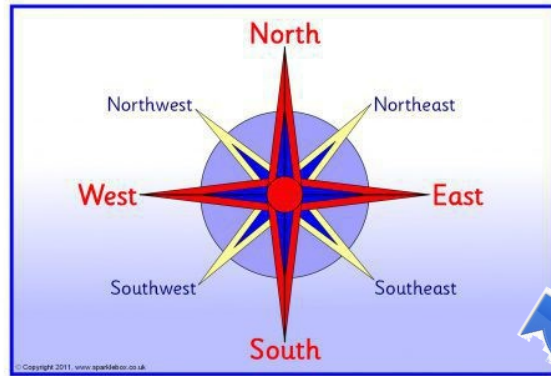


Geography

What have we already learnt?
 Children have briefly learnt about the 4 figure grid reference in Year 4 so they can continue this learning in Year 5. After this, children are ready to develop their learning in Year 6 to 6 figure grid references. Learning how to read a grid reference helps children to accurately locate places on a map.

Vocabulary	Definition
Scale	The ratio of the measurement on the drawing
Co ordinates	A point on a grid has two numbers to identify its position
Record	To write it down to remember
Four figure grid reference	Compass points used to locate a particular grid square on a map
