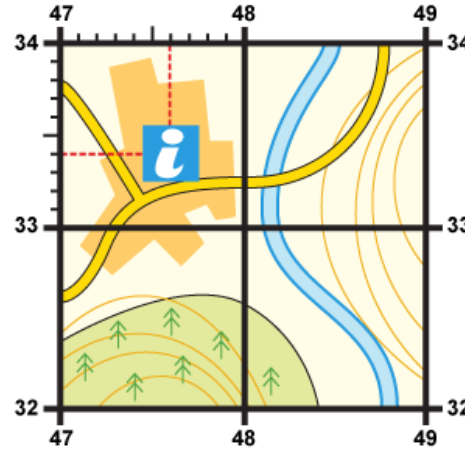

- Know how to read a six figure grid ref



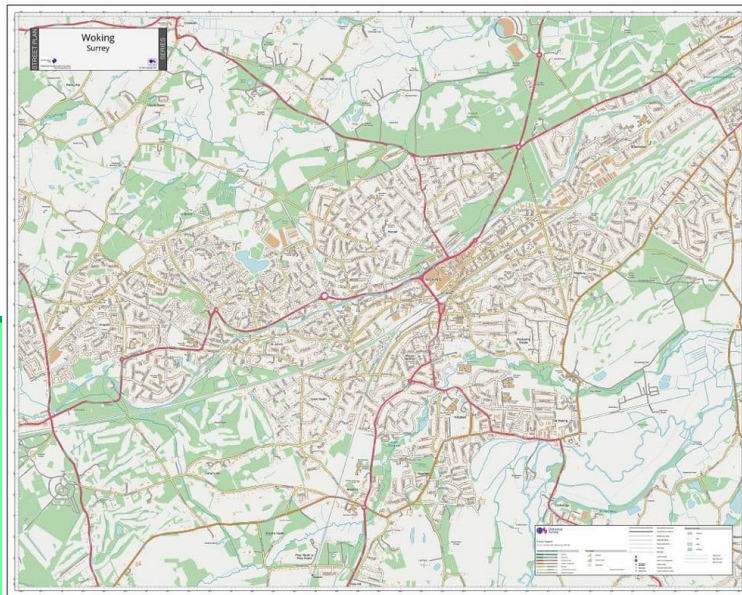
Can you work out the six figure grid reference for the information centre?

Vocabulary	Definition
Ordnance survey	Great Britain's national mapping agency
Symbol	Used to represent and distinguish features on a map
Six figure grid reference	more precise than a four figure grid reference. They are used to locate smaller locations
