



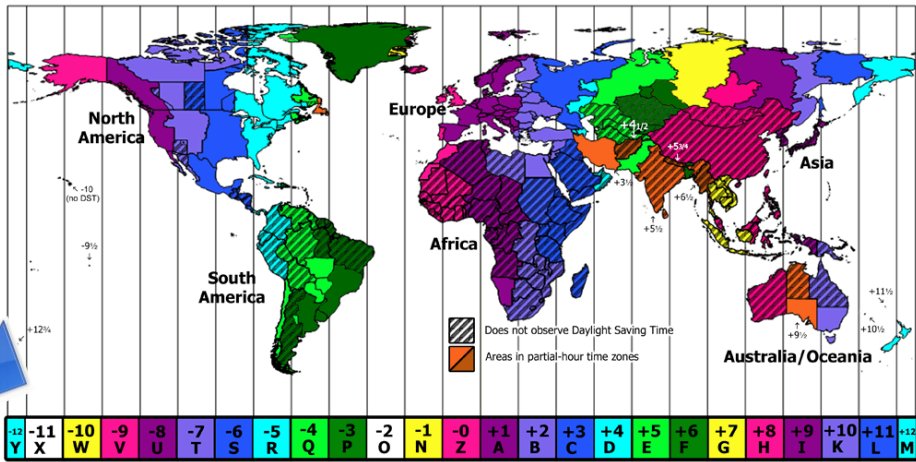
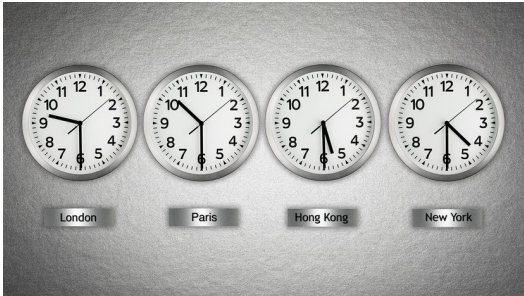

World time zones. Can you work out the time in

Vocabulary	Definition
Time zone	They are divided by imaginary lines called meridians which run from the North to the South Pole
Greenwich meridian	The yearly average (or 'mean') of the time each day when the Sun crosses the Prime Meridian at the Royal Observatory Greenwich.
Compare	We look to see what is the same about the two things.
