Key Knowledge

The internet is how all the Computers and devices around the world talk to each other. There are lots of things you can do online, like play games and talk to other people. Some people on the internet are kind, and some are unkind. Anything that goes on the internet stays there forever. There are rules we follow to keep ourselves safe on the internet.

Key Skills

- Understand that there are different uses for the internet beyond school (social media, online games, business)
- Understand how to safely switch on and switch off a laptop, computer or Ipad.
- Understand the difference between a friendly and unfriendly interaction
- Discuss how to behave online and begin to understand the implications of not doing so.
- Understand the SMART rules of Online Safety.

Internet	Using your device to talk to another device
Website	A page on the internet with something on
Trusted Adult	Someone who will always help you and keep you safe
Personal Information	Information about you that shows who you are
Share	Telling someone else something about yourself
Trust	When you know someone will be kind and help you
Forever	Never goes away, there always
Copy	Take information from somewhere else
Private	Something that is not to be shared
Password	Something that can keep your information safe
Search	Use a device to find something you're looking for


