



Year 1 Paint

You have already learnt...

In EYFS, you used the 2Simple paint software to use lots of different tools and colours to **create** a **picture**. You had a go at choosing **different colours** and using **different tools**.

Key Knowledge

Paint is a **program** on the **computer** which you can use to **create** different **pictures** and **images**. You can choose different **brushes** and change what **colour** and **size** they are. You can also create **shapes** and **fill** them in different **colours**. You can **create pictures** for lots of different reasons.

Key Skills

- Know how to use **Paint** with different **colours** and **brushes** to create an **image**
- Understand how to use the **undo** and **redo** buttons
- Know how to use the **Fill** button to **fill** a space quickly

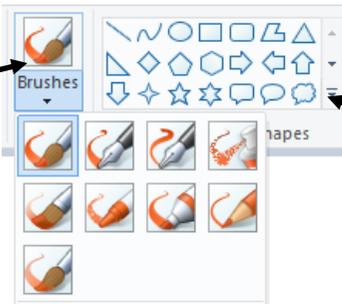


This bar will be at the top of your screen and you can **choose** which **colour** you'd like to use.

This button will let you **choose** how **thick** you would like your lines to be.

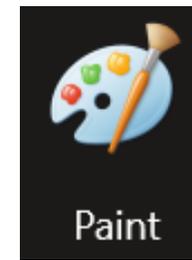
You can **click** on this button to choose from even more **colours**

You can **click** on this button to choose which kind of **tool** that you'd like to use - they all work differently and will have different **effects**.



If you choose a shape, you can **click and drag** to make it **bigger** or **smaller**.

This button will let you **fill** a **shape** or a **space** very quickly with one colour.

Word	Definition
Paint	Making marks and drawings on a screen using your mouse or your finger
Colours	The colour that you've chosen—it could be blue, red, green, yellow...
Brush	What you are using to make marks on your screen—you can change the type of brush that you use.
Undo	The last thing that you did will be undone or removed.
Redo	This means that the last action you did can be done again - you can't always use this.
Fill	Any shape can be filled in very quickly.
