You have already learnt...


You used a keyboard as part of your home corner in EYFS. You will have used an iPad **keyboard** for **typing** in EYFS and Year 1 during your time in the classroom. You have already had a go at using a **computer mouse** and looking at the screen.

Key Knowledge


The keyboard is the part of the **computer** you use to **type** words. You can do this on lots of different **programs**. When you have **typed** your work, you can change the **font** or the **colour**, or the **size**.

Key Skills

•Begin to use technology to share information through typing using two hands



This font menu is what you use to change the style of your writing, colour and size. You can also make it **bold** *italic* or underlined



This is the keyboard you might see on an iPad—they have lots of similar keys and buttons and the keyboard is the same.



This key will change your keyboard into being capital letters

This key will create finger spaces in your work on the Computer.

You can click this key to get rid of what you have done

You can click on this key to start a new line

We use a computer keyboard with two hands, and it is easier to reach certain keys with certain fingers

In Year 2 you will do another unit on typing, where you practise these skills and learn about more fonts, and how to change the size of your text.

Word	Definition
Keyboard	This is what you type onto to make your words and writing appear on the screen
Mouse	This is what you move around and use to click on different areas of your screen
Font	This is the style of your writing—you can change it and make it look a bit different
Capital	This is when the keys turn to the big letters you use for names or at the start of your sentence.
