Key Vocabulary

digital device	Any piece of equipment that contains a computer or microcontroller, such as a smartphone, smartwatch or laptop.
digital footprint	A digital footprint is a trail of information you leave behind when using apps and websites.
Internet	A large network of computers connected to each other all around the world.
keyword	The words we use when searching on a search engine, such as Google or KidRex.
online	Going online means connecting to the Internet . When you go online , you can connect to other places and other people.
personal information	This is information about yourself that can be used to identify you, such as your name or date of birth. Personal information should be kept private .
private	Keeping something private means not sharing information with anyone that you do not know.
search	You can use the Internet to search for information on a website .
website	A collection of web pages grouped together.

Top Tips for Online Searching

- Full sentences might not always be the best way to **search** for information **online**.
- Instead, think of some **keywords** that link to the topic you are **searching** for.
- Choose the best words to type into an **online search**.
