Key Knowledge

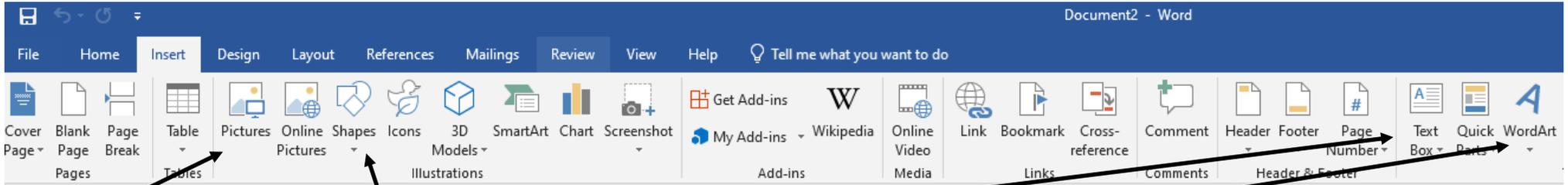
On **Microsoft Word** you can add **pictures** and **shapes** to make your work stand out. You can add a **text box** to type into so that you can move your writing around. You can also use **Word Art** to create interesting titles that will stand out.

- Understand how to take and record simple images and audio recordings

This is what you will click to get pictures onto your work

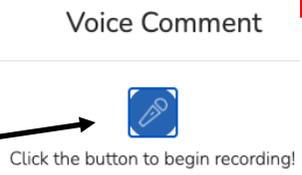
This will let you add different shapes to your posters

Word	Definition
Text Box	This is a box that you can draw on your word document and then type into
Word Art	Titles that look fancy and different that you can use on your posters to make them stand out
Shapes	You can draw different shapes on your document and change their colours
Pictures	You can copy these from the internet or a file to put onto your document
