








# Year 3 Powerpoint

| Key Vocabulary    |   |
|-------------------|---|
| <b>animation</b>  | A visual effect that can be applied to the text or pictures included on a <b>slide</b> .  |
| <b>format</b>     | The layout of the design, text or pictures on a <b>slide</b> . You can also <b>format</b> the font, size, colour and style of text.                           |
| <b>hyperlink</b>  | Text, images, buttons or moving images that can be used to move from document to document. They can even move from one place to another in the same document. |
| <b>multimedia</b> | Using more than one form of communication, such as text, graphics, <b>animation</b> and audio.  |
| <b>slide</b>      | A single page or image shown in a <b>multimedia slideshow</b> presentation.   |
| <b>slideshow</b>  | A collection of pages that can include different <b>multimedia</b> .  |
| <b>theme</b>      | A <b>slide</b> design that includes pre-existing colours, fonts and special effects, such as <b>animations</b> and <b>transitions</b> .                       |
| <b>transition</b> | A visual effect that happens between each <b>slide</b> .  |
