**You have already learnt...**




**Key Knowledge**

When you use information from the internet, you need to make sure you give credit to the source you got it from, or change the words to put it into your own words. Copying without acknowledging others is called plagiarism. Using a variety of different media will give your presentation more impact and enhance your work.

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Slide</b>	A slide is a single page of a presentation.
<b>Design</b>	The design is the style of the presentation- including the colour of the slides, font styles and layout.
<b>Transition</b>	A slide transition is the visual effect that occurs when you move from one slide to the next.
<b>Animation</b>	These are visual effects for objects in a PowerPoint. Animation brings objects like text, images, or charts on or off the slide.
<b>Slide Show</b>	This is another name for a presentation.
<b>Word Art</b>	This is a way of giving your text different effects.
<b>Text Box</b>	A special shape designed to place text onto slides.
