Key Knowledge

- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
- Knowledge of French phonics and pronunciation and the differences to the English
- Knowledge of what a verb is in English and knowledge of high frequency first person verbs such as je suis (I am), j'ai (I have) and j'habite (I live).

Key Skills

- **Speaking:** Say all vocabulary including some simple rhymes with accurate pronunciation.
- **Listening:** Listen to and recognise all vocabulary in target language without written form.
- **Reading:** Read all new vocabulary and simple rhymes without hearing first.
- **Writing:** Spell all new language as accurately as possible via tasks in each lesson.
