



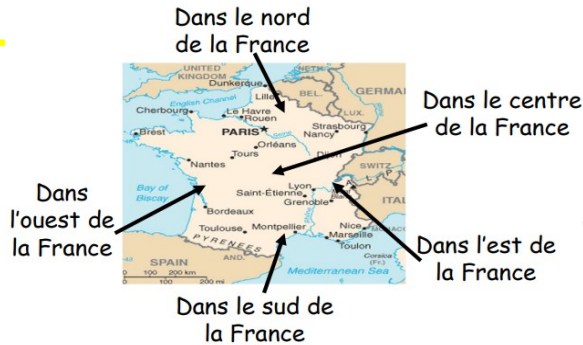
# Year 4 - French Quel Temps Fait-II?



- Key Knowledge**
- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
  - Knowledge that often in different languages, like in French, structures can be unique to that language. We say it is hot but in French it is 'doing' hot! In English we say it is sunny but in French 'there is' sun. It does not make perfect sense in English, but it is how it is expressed in French! Understanding it is not always a word for word translation.
  - Knowledge of different types of weather
  - Knowledge of what a noun and article/determiner is in English.

- Key Skills**
- **Speaking:** Ask and answer what the weather is like today in French and present as a weather forecaster
  - **Listening:** Listen to and recognise all vocabulary in French without written form.
  - **Reading:** Read all new vocabulary within sentences and understand the content.
  - **Writing:** Create weather map and written weather report.

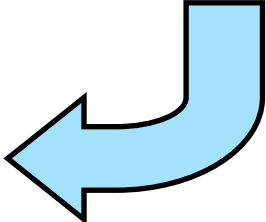
