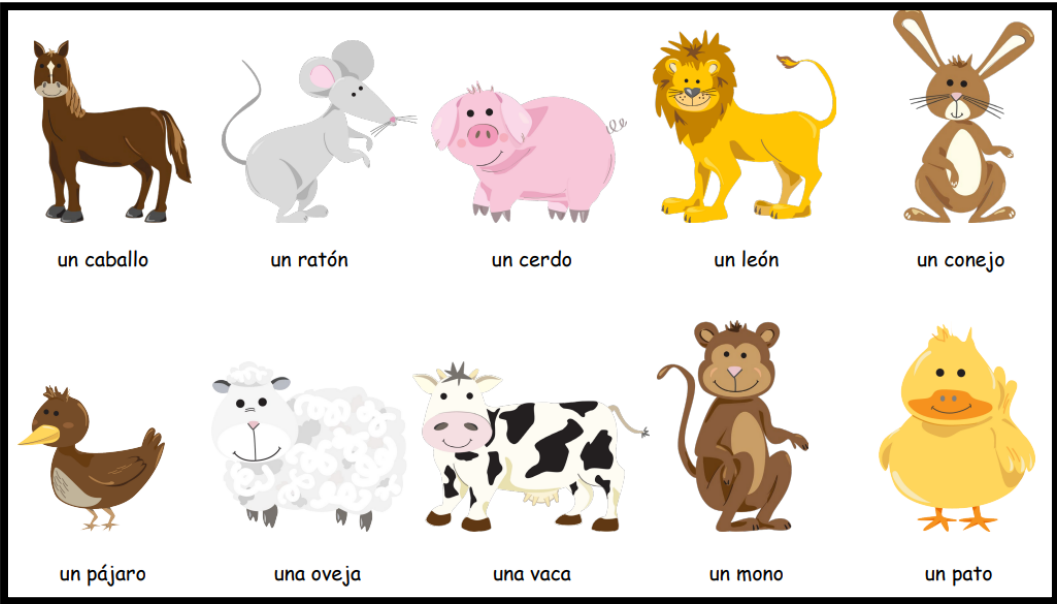
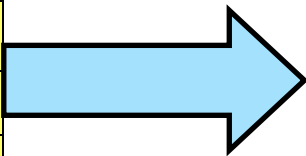

- Key Knowledge**
- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
 - Knowledge of Spanish phonics and pronunciation and the differences to the English
 - Knowledge of the planets and what they look like/key features
 - Knowledge of what an adjective is in English.
 - Knowledge of adjectival agreement - how adjectives can (and often do) change spelling in Spanish depending if the noun they are describing is a singular, plural, masculine or feminine noun.
 - Knowledge of what a noun and article/determiner is in English.
 - Knowledge of what a verb is and that 'I am' comes from the verb 'to be' in English.

- Key Skills**
- **Speaking:** Say the names of some animals in Spanish with their correct article/determiner from memory and with high accuracy. Use the verb 'soy' (I am) with each animal name in Spanish.
 - **Listening:** Match sound to animal picture/word/phrase.
 - **Reading:** Match word to animal picture/word/phrase in English.
 - **Writing:** Write the names of the animals in Spanish, with accurate spelling.
