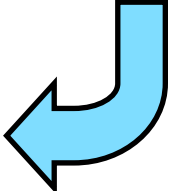
- Key Knowledge**
- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
  - Knowledge of Spanish phonics and pronunciation and the differences to the English
  - Knowledge of what a verb is in English and knowledge of high frequency first person verbs such as soy (I am), tengo (I have) and vivo (I live).
  - Knowledge of adjectival agreement - how adjectives can (and often do) change spelling in Spanish depending if the noun they are describing is a singular, plural, masculine or feminine noun.
  - Knowledge of possessive adjectives in Spanish with a focus only on 'my'. Understanding that there are 'two words in Spanish mi and mis for our one word 'my' in English.

- Key Skills**
- **Speaking:** Perform role play with name, age, where they live and nationality
  - **Listening:** Listen to and match sound to picture /word / phrase.
  - **Reading:** Read role plays and understand the content.
  - **Writing:** Write some basic sentences about yourself, using the learnt vocabulary and phrases.
