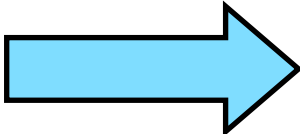

- Key Knowledge**
- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
 - Knowledge of Spanish phonics and pronunciation and the differences to the English
 - Knowledge that tengo means I have and comes from the verb to have tener in Spanish.
 - Knowledge of what a noun and article/determiner is in English.
 - Knowledge of what a verb is in English.
 - Knowledge that punctuation can be different with the upside-down exclamation and question mark at the start of a sentence
 - Knowledge that nouns in Spanish have gender and that this affects the choice of article/ determiner.

- Key Skills**
- **Speaking:** Repeat all learnt classroom objects in Spanish with their correct indefinite article/ determiners from memory with high accuracy. Explain what I have and do not have in my pencil case from memory with high accuracy.
 - **Listening:** Listen to and match sound to picture / word / phrase.
 - **Reading:** Read text about a classroom/a pencil case and understand the content.
 - **Writing:** Write some basic sentences about your classroom/pencil case (what you have and don't have in them)
