



# Year 6 - Spanish Las Olimpiadas

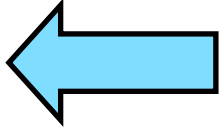

- Key Knowledge**
- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
  - Knowledge of Spanish phonics and pronunciation and the differences to the English
  - Knowledge of how to listen to and approach longer texts in Spanish
  - Knowledge of the different types of weather
  - Knowledge that punctuation can be different with the upside-down exclamation and question mark at the start of a sentence
  - Knowledge that often in different languages, like in Spanish, structures can be unique to that language. Understanding it is not always a word for word translation and there can be fixed expressions to learn.

- Key Skills**
- **Speaking:** Say some key facts from the history of the ancient and modern Olympic games in Spanish. Say all the nouns for the 10 sports and their correct gender in Spanish. Say what sports you can and can't play using the verb, practicar.
  - **Listening:** Listen to and understand the majority of a short text about the Olympics/sports.
  - **Reading:** Read and understand the majority of a short text about the Olympics/sports.
  - **Writing:** Spell all new language as accurately as possible and write about what sports you can and can't do.
