- Key Knowledge**
- Knowledge of the key vocabulary
  - Knowledge of Spanish phonics and pronunciation and the differences to the English
  - Knowledge of how to listen to and approach longer texts in Spanish
  - Knowledge of the different types of weather
  - Knowledge that punctuation can be different with the upside-down exclamation and question mark at the start of a sentence
  - Knowledge that often in different languages, like in Spanish, structures can be unique to that language. Understanding it is not always a word for word translation and there can be fixed expressions to learn.

- Key Skills**
- **Speaking:** Ask and answer what the weather is like today in Spanish and present as a weather forecaster
  - **Listening:** Listen to and recognise all vocabulary in Spanish without written form.
  - **Reading:** Read all new vocabulary within sentences and understand the content.
  - **Writing:** Create weather map and written weather report.
