Creative Curriculum:

<u>Science</u>	Plants, bean investigation
<u>Computing</u>	Online Safety - Digiduck's Famous Friend Scratch JR, Paint
<u>Art</u>	Portrait sketching/painting - focus on spatial awareness. Famous Kings and Queens of the past Nicky Philipps - Portrait Painter to the Royals.
<u>D.T.</u>	Plan, cut, make and taste a fruit salad.
<u>Music</u>	Charanga: singing, listen and identify instruments, appreciate different types of music.
<u>History</u>	Name a famous person from the past and explain why they are famous. Look at a famous king or queen.
<u>Geography</u>	Know which is the hottest and coldest season in the UK. Know and recognise main weather symbols. Know the main differences between city, town and village.

Mathematics

- **Number:** Place value tens and ones, counting forwards and backwards to 100 from any number, addition and subtract word problems, multiplication, ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd...).
- **Mental Maths:** Counting to and across 100 forwards and backwards, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, one more/less, number bonds to 10 and 20, doubles/halves up to 20.
- **Measure:** Telling the time o'clock and half past, use language relating to dates including days of the week and months of the year, measure/record time.
- **Space:** Whole, half and quarter turns.
- **Shape:** Name basic 2D and 3D shapes.
- **Using and Applying:** show your working out using a range of methods and resources, draw and write explanations for your solution, use and compare in different scenarios - would it still work? Create your own problems in the same way.

Literacy

- **Punctuation:** Finger spaces, capital letters, full stops and question marks
- **Grammar:** noun, verb suffixes ing, ed, er, est, adjective prefix -un, conjunction 'and'.
- **Spelling:** Linked to phonics learning weekly, applying alternate 'special friends', red words.
- **Handwriting:** lower/upper case letters, number formation
- **Reading:** Phonics and Comprehension skills; develop some fluency and expression, using 'Fred in your head' to increase the pace.
- **Writing:** Non-fiction genres - description, recount
