Creative Curriculum

Science - Everyday materials, Forces,

History - Events beyond living memory that are

significant nationally (Gun Powder Plot); Mary Seacole

Mathematics

Number: Place value; addition and subtraction, multiplication and division

Measure: Using measuring equipment when finding length, using standard and non-standard measures; comparing measures and choosing the correct units of measure/equipment; telling the time to the nearest quarter hour

Mental Maths: Counting forwards and backwards from 0-100; number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.

Personal and Social Development

R.E - Who is Jesus? Parables and the Christmas story

Learning for Life - internet safety and rules; Keeping myself safe; Me & my relationships including feelings, emotions, conflict resolution, friendship

Literacy

Transcription: daily phonics/spelling practise, daily handwriting practise.

Composition: Writing a recount
Writing instructions with use of imperative verbs and chronological order
Story writing- Superhero story/ Christmas story. Planning ideas.

Vocabulary, grammar and punctuation:

Use of capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, question marks to demarcate sentences. Regular use of phonics in order to support spelling
Use of noun phrases and conjunctions (and, but, so, or)
