Bikeability Cycle Training Level 1 2nd and 4th November 2026 Year 4 Classes

Surrey County Council National Standard for cycle training is called 'Bikeability'. Level 1 is primarily for Year 4 students and Level 2 is for Year 6 pupils.

We are pleased to be able to offer our Year 4 classes, Kingfishers and Woodpeckers, a Bikeability Level 1 cycle training course provided by Surrey County Council **free of charge**. Training will take place over the following dates:

- 2nd November - Monday
- 4th November - Wednesday

Bikeability require the course to be booked using their own website. If you wish your child to participate in the above-mentioned course, please book and consent online using the Bikeability website link, as below:

When you finish the enrolment process you should receive a confirmation email from the Surrey County Council cycle training team. We will then allocate your child to a specific course and you will receive a further email confirming the date and time of the course. Bikeability groups will have a maximum of 12 pupils.

Please note that enrolment closes on **9:10AM on 17th October 2026**. This course is not suitable for a child who is unable to ride a bike.

Bikeability Level 1 cycle training improves balance and control skills. Further information about what is involved is available on the Bikeability website. At the end of the course your child will receive a Bikeability Level 1 badge, certificate and booklet.

You will need to have your child's cycle in school for the start of the day of the course. Cycles can be stored, at your own risk, in the bike shed at the front of the school. Please ensure your child has the key or code to their bike lock. Cycles must be in a mechanically safe condition. Please check your child's cycle, referring to the cycle check guide available on the Bikeability website. BMX bikes must have both brakes fitted.

The Bikeability team recommend that your child wears a helmet. All helmets should be correctly fitted. Please refer to the helmet guides available on the Bikeability website. The Highway Code suggests cyclists should wear a helmet "which conforms to current regulations, is the correct size and securely fastened".

The Bikeability team also recommended that your child wears trousers or jogging bottoms and non-slip footwear, which could be PE trainers. Your child will be required to wear school uniform on their top half. They should arrive for school dressed for Bikeability and may remain in the same clothes for the rest of the day. They may also need a coat as the training takes place outside on the playground.
