Mathematics – numbers & shape, space and measure

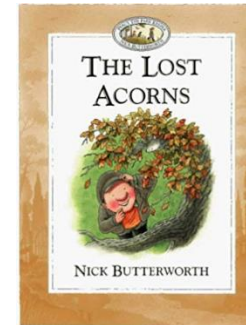
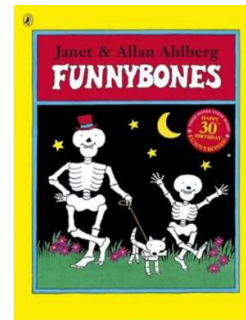
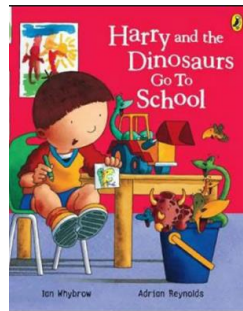
Number

Expressive Arts and Design

This half term we will be...

- Experimenting and exploring colour mixing, and using different textures in our art work.
- Creating artwork using natural materials we find around the school grounds.
- Learning to evaluate and reflect on our work and make changes when necessary.

Understanding the World

This half term we will be exploring our new environment and investigating how the seasons are changing through our plants and trees. We will be finding out what happens in the different areas of school and about all the different people who work there. We will also be finding out about the people who help us in our immediate surroundings. We will be exploring some of the facilities Westfield has to offer and finding out about how they support our community. We will be looking at 'What makes us special?' in RE and celebrating harvest as a school.

Literacy – reading & writing

In phonics we will be learning all the sounds using Jolly Phonics. We will be learning how to identify these sounds in words as well as blending and segmenting these sounds into simple CVC words. We will focus on how to hold our pencil using the correct tripod grip, form our letters correctly and writing our name. We will be rehearsing our skills through reading and writing labels as well as word and sentence building games.
