Dear Parents and Carers,

Due to our commitment to keeping our children and staff as protected as possible for COVID-19, we follow government guidelines to schools carefully and as fully as we can. One aspect of this is that good and continuous ventilation in classrooms can prevent the virus spreading and, therefore, we keep our windows, and doors, open as much as possible throughout the school day.

As we head towards the colder months of the year, it is therefore important that children come into school dressed appropriately. The children are still required to wear their school uniform on two or three days a week, their sports clothes on their PE days and mufti or sports mufti (as an option if it is their PE day) on Fridays, as they have been doing this half term.

To ensure your child is warm enough in school:

### **School uniform days**

- Under-garments that provide warmth, such as vests, t-shirts, long sleeved t-shirts **under their school t-shirt / shirt. A school jumper, school cardigan or school burgundy fleece must be worn as the top layer.**
- Grey trousers, grey skirt ~~or grey~~ and school tights (not leggings)/ socks must be worn as part of the top layer.

### **PE days**

- Plain tracksuit top or school jumper with undergarments such as vests, t-shirt, long sleeved t-shirt
- Plain tracksuit or jogging trousers

### **Mufti days**

- Please make sure your child is in clothing that is suitable for school and sufficiently warm.

Please remember that children should wear clean clothes into school each day to lessen the chance of the virus being spread into school from homes and vice versa.
