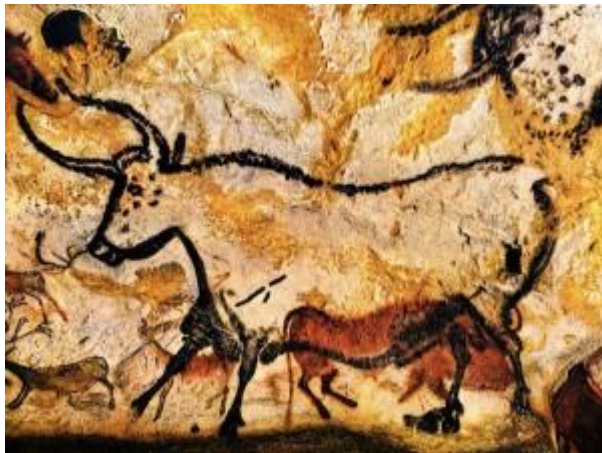


## Places to visit/ Outdoor ideas
