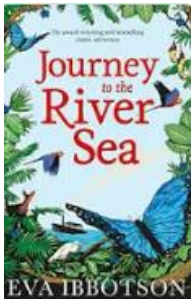

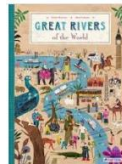


## Things to make or do

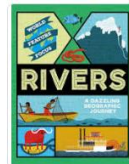
- ☐ Design and make an exotic bird/animal from the Amazon River

## Research Ideas and Books to share

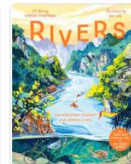
- ☐ Use books and/or internet sources to find out more about rivers and their features

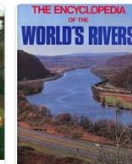

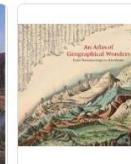

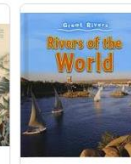
